This charming bug family (mama is a ladybug and papa is a daddy longlegs) share a day in Bug City, where they go shopping (for calico moths and velvet ants, of course) and visit the zoo (with rhinoceros beetles and ant lions). The bug

family goes to work, cleans house, goes shopping, and enjoys a parade and the zoo. Children of all ages will be entranced by these bright colorful illustrations--a monarch butterfly riding a goldbug coach pulled by horseflies--and familiar end-of-day activities like dinner and bedtime where "only glowworms and the lightning bugs light up the darkness with their small lights." Ipcar's flamboyant, four-color illustrations make for an amusing and quirky book in which children can also learn to identify many different kinds of insects. Ipcar was a well-known artist of the WPA-era and also illustrated a number of other children's books. Ipcar's works are now in the permanent collections of museums such as the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Whitney Museum of American Art, and the Brooklyn Museum in New York. She is also represented in the leading art museums of Maine, as well as in many corporate and private collections throughout the country.

night to experience the bugs! In this colorful picture book, Himmelman introduces the sounds of "noisy bugs" and invites children to sing along with them. Each double-page spread focuses on one insect, with a line of text, such as "A Dog-Day Cicada buzzes LOUDLY high in a tree. / ZZZZZZZZ," and a meticulously drawn, large-scale image of the animal, with color, texture, and shading apparently added digitally. The big, bold images make the illustrations inviting to children, while the accurate depictions of individual insects reward closer study. Among those featured are the tiger moth (SQUEAKA-SQUEAKA-SQUEAK), the mosquito (mmmmmm), and the bush katydid (tick-tick-tick zeezeezeezee). In contrast, the butterfly flies by in silence. An appended section provides the sound waves (on paper and, through a link, in audio files) recorded for each example; a paragraph of information about each bug and its sound; and good children's activities for related of insect sounds. Amid the variety of human experiences, the comic occupies a distinctive place. It is simultaneously ubiquitous, relative, and fragile. In this book, Peter L. Berger reflects on the nature of the comic and its relationship to other human experiences. Berger

contends that the comic is an integral aspect of human life, yet one that must be approached and analyzed circumspectly and circuitously. Other unique features of this book include teacher-friendly lists of correspondences and various regularities not described by previous authorities, for example the strong tendency for the letter-name vowel phonemes (the names of the letters ) to be spelt with those single letters in non-final syllables.
